Have fun, be kind, do good.

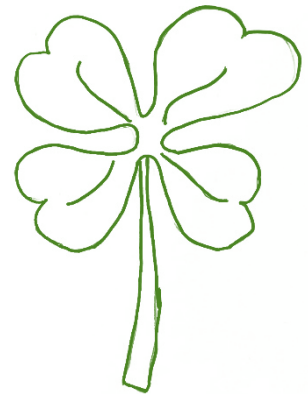

Not a thing without joy.

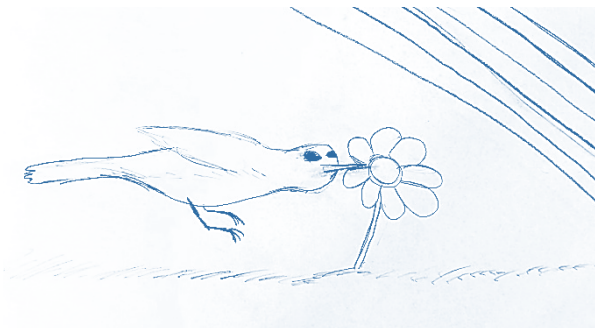
