Can any student join Math Club?

We welcome students who may struggle in math, students who need an extra challenge, and everyone in between. We strive to make Math Club accessible and valuable to all learners.

What type of material do the students work on?

Math Club is all about games and explorations that go beyond what students learn in the math classroom. We may play games such as Contig or Hex, explore ideas like Pascal's triangle and coordinate graphing, or construct things like pentominoes and origami.

Is there homework for Math Club?

There is no homework but we love it when kids spread the math love at home and tell you about what we work on. We also hope to have a newsletter with information about our activities that you might enjoy at home.

Can my 4th or 5th grader do both Math Club and Math Team?

Yes of course! Most students choose one or the other but we always have a few who just can't get enough.
